## **KMC Trampoline Team Flying High at Fairland**

The KMC Trampoline Team dominated the trampoline competition at Fairland with greater than 50% of the KMC athletes wining first or second place on trampoline in their respective age groups and levels. Fairland is the largest regular season competition in the region where more than 550 competitors, from 34 teams competed on March 28 and 29.

The complete results are below:

Matthew Wileyto competed at level 9 on both trampoline and double mini. On trampoline, he completed his highest and best optional routine of the season. Wileyto won second place on trampoline and third on double mini in the 15-and-over age group. Mateo Reihman completed solid level 9 routines, on trampoline, for 11-and-12 year old boys and won second place. He placed sixth on double mini, at level 8.

It was a first place sweep for KMC level 7 competitors, Kate Elliott, Isaac Hannah, Chayse D'Andrade, Adam Overman, and Jordan Walchuk. They showed their power and technique on trampoline and took first place in every age group that they competed in. The compulsory team is training hard to duplicate their team win from last season at the State and Regional competitions.

On double mini, Overman posted an amazingly high score of 29.3 out of 30 to win first place for his age group of 11-and-12 year old boys. Walchuk was second for girls 8-and-under; D'Andrade and Elliot were third for girls 11-and-12 and 13-and-14, respectively.

In level 6 competition, Maddison Townsend came in second on trampoline doing a great routine with some very tough competition for 13-and-14 year old girls. Sarah Acland placed fourth on trampoline for 11-and-12 year old girls. Cullan Darhower was fifth on trampoline for 11-and-12 year old boys.

In the 11-and-12 year old level 5 boys group, JD Mickel showed off his wonderful airplane to win first on trampoline; he also placed third on double mini.

For girls in the same age category, Hannah Watson placed second on level 4 trampoline with a beautiful routine.

All three synchronized trampoline pairs involving KMC athletes performed well. Elliott/Walchuk put up their highest score of the season of 32.7.

In tumbling, the athletes persevered even though they don't have a rod floor to practice on. Both Reihman and Walchuk placed third in their respective age groups at level 5.
