Jordan Walchuk won the level 7 trampoline title, for girls 8 and under, at the USAG level 5-7 National Championship last week in Dallas, TX. Walchuk had an impressive showing where she scored a nine or above, out of a possible ten points, from each of the three judges. Walchuk finished second on double mini. Last year Walchuk won the National trampoline title at level 5.

Also competing this year at level 7, Isaac Hannah finished 8th on trampoline for boys ages 13-14. In level 6 competition, Danielle Birkett won 7th place on trampoline for girls ages 13-14 and Sadie Acland placed 7th on double mini for girls 12 years old. JD Mickel competed at level 5 and received 8th place on double mini for boys 11-12 years old.

The KMC trampoline team also sent athletes to the National Championship for levels 8-Elite in Greensboro, NC. Mateo Reihman won 8th place for boys 11-12 on level 9 trampoline. Reihman also placed 7th on double mini in level 8 competition.
